# Screen Sharing with Your Service Representative

When you call into your Service team, sometimes it helps to have the service representative show you how to do something-right on your own computer. Sharing your screen is easy and secure, using a screen sharing application called Bomgar™.


To start screen sharing, your service representative will ask you to click this link <a href="https://OneSupport.adp.com">https://OneSupport.adp.com</a> and will provide you with a one-time session key.

When you click the link, an application is temporarily downloaded to your computer. As soon as the session ends, the application is removed.

During the screen sharing session, the service representative can see everything on your screen so **take a moment to close or minimize anything confidential**. With your permission, the service representative can take control of the mouse to show you how to do something, but you will see everything he does and you can take back control at any time.

#### How Do I Share My Screen?

- When you are both ready, the service representative will ask you to click this link <a href="https://OneSupport.adp.com">https://OneSupport.adp.com</a> and will give you a one-time session key.
- 2 Enter the session key and click Submit.



**Note**: A session key isn't required if the service representative sends you an email with the link.


3 Click **Yes** to begin the support session.




4 Next, download the install file. This step varies depending on the browser you are using. Click the link for your browser for details.

Take a moment to read the message. If you agree to the terms, select I have read and agree to the terms above and click **OK**.



When you are ready to share your screen, click **Allow** to let your service representative take control of your cursor.




7 This window is displayed throughout the session. Click the red X at any time to end the session.



## Downloading a file in Internet Explorer


In the Download window, click **Run** to download the temporary screen sharing application. It takes about 30 seconds to install.

Double click the file to download the temporary screen sharing application. It takes about 30 seconds to install.


